The Istituto Italiano di Cultura of Toronto, founded in 1976, is a government agency in Canada operating under the jurisdiction of the Italian Foreign Office.

The Istituto's main office is located at 496 Huron Street, north of Bloor and two blocks east of Spadina Road with subway access from the Spadina and St. George stations. Parking is available nearby.

The Istituto's Language and Culture Learning Centre in Vaughan is located at 4550 Highway 7, suite 210, west of Pine Valley Drive. Free parking is accessible both from Highway 7 or Pine Valley Drive.

WHY TAKE A COURSE AT THE ISTITUTO?

- Our courses follow the Common European Framework set by the European Council.
- Our instructors are all native speakers and experienced teachers of Italian.

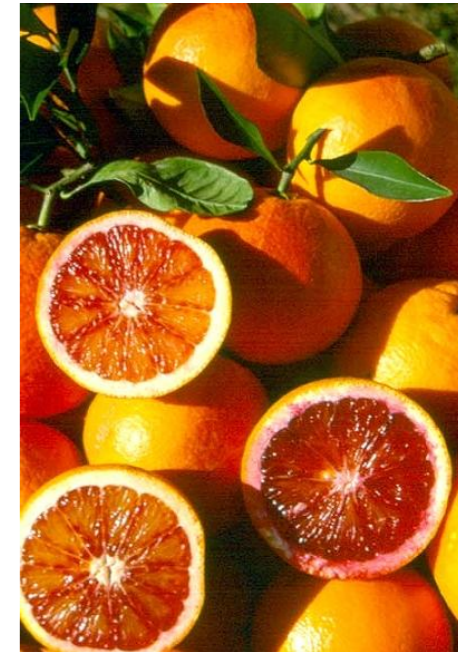

Beginner I

This course is an introduction to the basic elements of the language. Emphasis is placed on oral communication, pronunciation and vocabulary acquisition. Students will study the present tense of regular and of most common irregular verbs; definite and indefinite articles; subject pronouns; simple prepositions.

Beginner II

As in Beginner I, emphasis is placed on basic communicative strategies as well as fundamental grammar & vocabulary. Topics include: present perfect and future tenses; compound prepositions.

Intermediate I

This course enriches the students' knowledge of current expressions and vocabulary and introduces the following grammatical structures: possessive adjectives; imperfect & pluperfect tenses; direct object pronouns.

Intermediate II

Students will have the opportunity to enhance their basic communication skills while learning additional vocabulary and more complex grammatical structures such as: reflexive verbs; indirect object pronouns; imperative; present and past conditional.

Intermediate Plus

This course explores more advanced structures of Italian grammar such as: combined and relative pronouns and comparative adjectives.

Advanced I & II

In Advanced I & II you will study the subjunctive and the gerund. Special emphasis is placed on hypothetical phrases and agreement of the tenses as well as idiomatic forms.

Italian Grammar & Stylistics

This course is ideal for students who wish to gain a better understanding of Italian syntax and stylistics while improving written communication in Italian. Various written samples (novels, newspaper articles) will be analysed. Some emphasis will also be placed on figurative speech expressions. Completion of Advanced II or equivalent is required.

Conversation I & II

Through simple literary readings and analysis of newspaper and magazine articles, the instructor will guide conversation and discussions on current events. Students will have the opportunity to put in practice the grammatical structures learned in the *Beginner & Intermediate* courses and acquire additional relevant vocabulary.

Review I & II

These courses are designed for those who need a general review of the grammatical structures learned in Beginner I & II (Review I) and Intermediate I & II (Review II) before advancing to the next level.

Italian for Business

Designed for those who are professionally involved in the business and international trade, the course focuses on both oral and written expressions and provides students with specific related vocabulary.

Italian for Opera Lovers

A grammar review course at the Beginner II/Intermediate level in which students listen to and analyze some of the most famous Italian arias. A great course for students who are looking for not only a less intense grammar review but also a fun linguistic experience.

Italian Poetry and Composition

Through the study of various Italian poets ranging from Dante Alighieri to Giuseppe Ungaretti, this course aims to help students expand and improve their vocabulary, grammar and composition skills.

TUITION AND REGISTRATION FEES

The tuition fee is \$280 for 25 hours of instruction plus textbooks.

All students will receive a free annual **IIC membership**. Membership gives free access to the Istituto's library and videotape collection, free admission to selected Italian film screenings and cultural events. Free WI-FI also available on premises. Fees are payable **by cheque or debit only**. Cheques should be made out to the **Istituto Italiano di Cultura**. Cheques will be put on hold until the start date of the course. **Fees do not include textbooks**.

CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

The Istituto reserves the right to cancel any course should the number of students registered for that course be insufficient. In this case, cheques on hold will be returned. **No refund is granted after course commencement. However, if a student is not able to attend a course and notifies us within 7 days from the date of commencement fees can be accredited to a subsequent term.**

CERTIFICAZIONE

The Istituto is the only place in Toronto where the Certification of Italian Proficiency exams (esami CILS) are held. This certification is a requirement for all students who wish to study at Italian universities.

TEXTBOOKS

Textbooks and optional course material can be purchased directly at the Italian Cultural Institute.

PLACEMENT TEST & EXAMINATION POLICY

A placement test can be provided before registration to determine proficiency. Students may opt to sit for an examination to qualify for a certificate of proficiency.

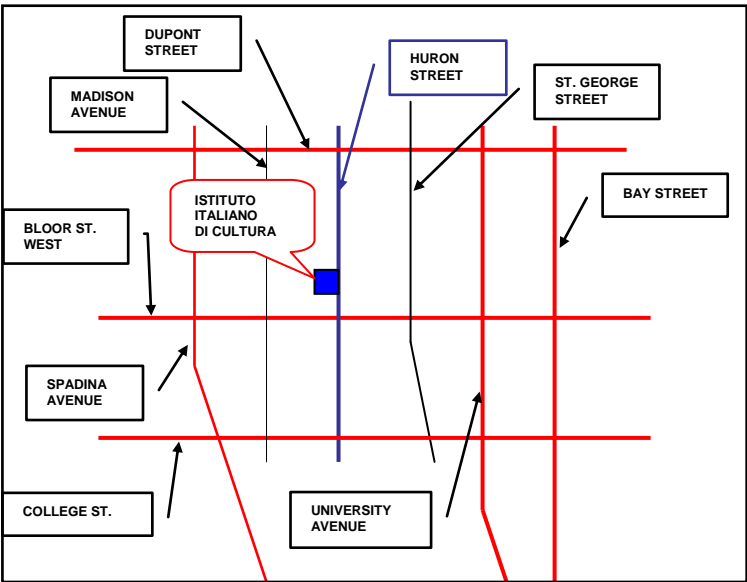
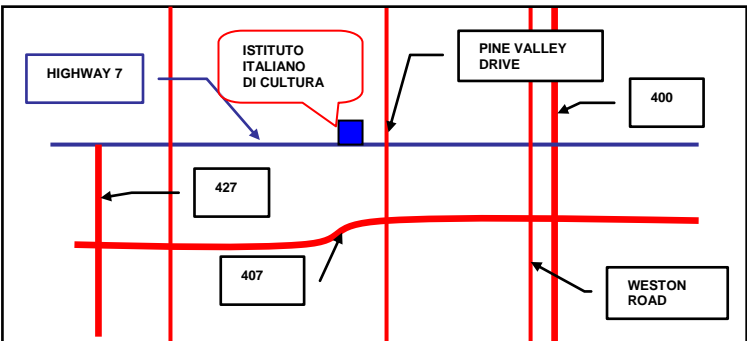
